Guwahati, May 26: Yubraj Barthakur, the youthful and vivacious Additional Deputy Commissioner of Cachar, passed away on Sunday afternoon in a Hyderabad hospital. In his early forties, Barthakur abandoned his wife. According to a source in the local government, Barthakur's dead remains will be transported by air to his birthplace of Dibrugarh on Monday. According to a person close to Barthakur, he has been dealing with a



pancreatic issue for the past 12 months. He was recently admitted to a hospital in Silchar,

and following his recovery, he was transported to Hyderabad for additional medical care.

Congressman Gaurav Gogoi calls an investigation into illicit coal mining



Guwahati, May 26: Gaurav Gogoi Congress MP from Jorhat, demanded that thorough probe be conducted into syndicates and suspected illegal coal mining in Assam and Meghalaya. Speaking to a press conference at Jorhat's District Congress Bhawan, Gogoi asserted that “coal mafia” flourishing under political cover and connected it to shifts in Assam's leadership. Gogoi said, “Yesterday in Delhi, Prime Minister Narendra Modi addressed Rising North East summit where he spoke of private investment. I wrote to him the same day

highlighting the ground reality in Assam and Meghalaya the illegal coal syndicate.” Congress MP claims Enforcement Directorate action revealed illegal coal transportation in Meghalaya using forged documents and alleged bribes, but states no significant action by Assam or Meghalaya govts. “This reminds me of the Umrangshu incident where nine labourers died in an illegal rat-hole mine. A subsequent probe revealed 245 such operations in Assam. This could not happen without political protection,” Gogoi alleged.

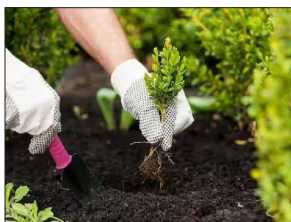
Bolti Khamoshi, book published in Dibrugarh

Guwahati, May 27: Prime Minister Narendra Modi commended Assam's tenacious fight against child marriage and cited it as a model for other states during the NDA Chief Ministers' Conclave in New Delhi. Assam's chief minister, Himanta Biswa Sarma, provided a comprehensive overview of his government's efforts to prevent child marriage, emphasizing the value of both public backing and consistent police enforcement. According to the Chief Minister's Office, the program has significantly decreased the state's caseload.

The prime minister apparently suggested that other NDA-ruled states should adopt



similar strategies to Assam's in order to prevent child marriage, which continues to affect gender equality, public health, and education in many parts of the country.

Furthermore, Modi directed senior federal government representatives to visit Assam in order to discover how local enforcement, policy

focus, and community involvement had contributed to the successful fight against the practice.

The conclave covered a wide range of subjects, including education, water conservation, and women's empowerment, but Assam's achievements in reducing child marriage were particularly important.

PM Modi flagged new Siemens D9 electric locomotive



New Delhi, May 27: The first 9000 HP electric locomotive in India has started to be delivered by Siemens, with key parts being constructed at its plants in Nashik, Aurangabad, and Mumbai. Prime Minister Narendra Modi officially opened India's first D9-9000 HP electric locomotive at Indian Railways' cutting-edge Dahod, Gujarat, facility on May 26, 2025. This powerful locomotive, which was created in partnership with Siemens, ushers in a new era in rail freight transportation in India by establishing new benchmarks for sustainability, technology, and domestic production. The D9 is a prime example of the government's "Make in India" campaign with almost 90% of its parts manufactured in India. Siemens produced the required parts through its manufacturing facilities in Nashik, Aurangabad, and Mumbai. Siemens is in charge of the design, engineering & maintenance of

1,200 of these locomotives. Constructed in less than two years, the Dahod facility has contemporary conveniences such locomotive simulators, effective carriage movement systems, and safety training based on virtual reality. Siemens Limited's MD and CEO, Sunil Mathur, referred to the project as a "commendable achievement" and emphasized how it helped raise the rail freight share from 27% to 45%.

With an estimated 800 million tons of CO2 emissions saved during its lifetime, the locomotive's debut demonstrates India's dedication to environmentally friendly transportation. Siemens has acquired 1,200 powerful D9 freight locomotives, each with a 9000 HP engine, 120 km/h top speed, and 5,800 tons capacity. Locomotives will be maintained using Railigent X for predictive maintenance and equipped with advanced digital tracking and green propulsion technologies.

Scientists fear that a container ship sinking near Kerala could cause an oil catastrophe

Chennai, May 27: Authorities must attempt to contain as much oil and pollution as possible offshore because onshore cleanup has limitations, particularly during the monsoon season. This is true even as the Indian Navy and Coast Guard race to contain any oil spill from the MSC Elsa 3 container ship, which sank Sunday. In the meantime, teams of researchers from the Agriculture Ministry's CMFRI have spread out over three coastal regions in Kerala to gather sediment and water samples in order to investigate onshore effects. Using booms,



sprays, and bioremediation, offshore containment would be essential to managing any possible spill, according to Deepak Apte, a renowned marine biologist and current director of the nonprofit Srushti Conservation

Foundation. Apte has spearheaded the investigation into the oil spill resulting from the August 7, 2010, collision between the MSC Chitra and the MV Khalijia III as a member of the BNHS. Over 800 tons

of oil leaked into the ocean as a result of the catastrophe, harming thousands of mangroves in the districts of Raigad and Mumbai as well as marine life. "Monsoon has made an onset and the currents are towards the shore. With the monsoon tides and surges, access to shore areas will be difficult for clean ups if the oil slicks reach the coast. A lot will depend on how much quantum of oil is actually reaching the shore. In 2010, we saw that a lot of oil got deposited in the mangroves and mudflats and that is extremely difficult to clean up," Apte said.

DUSU President's Office Smears Cow Dung After Rahul Gandhi's DU Visit

New Delhi, May 27: After Congress leader Rahul Gandhi's surprise visit to Delhi University last week, two events at the North Campus on Monday have heightened political tensions. A protest march was organized by the Akhil Bharatiya Vidyarthi Parishad charged Gandhi with breaking university rules by coming without authorization. In a separate video, Rishabh Chaudhary, the leader of the ABVP and a previous contender for DUSU president, was seen putting cow excrement on DUSU president's office. Under the name "Chhatra Saman Yatra," the ABVP staged a

protest march on Monday that began at Kirori Mal College and ended at the DUSU office. Officials claim that the demon-

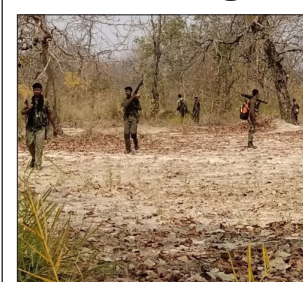

18 Naxalites give up in state of Chhattisgarh



Surat, May 27: Up to 18 Naxalites, 10 of whom had a total reward of ₹38 lakh, turned themselves in to security forces in the Sukma district of Chhattisgarh on Tuesday, according to police. According to Sukma Superintendent of Police Kiran Chavan, the cadres surrendered in front of senior police and CRPF officials here, expressing dissatisfaction with "hollow" and "inhuman" Maoist philosophy as well as ultras' atrocities against indigenous tribals. "They also expressed their admiration for the new surrender and rehabilitation policy and the state government's 'Niyad Nellanar' scheme, which aims to facilitate development projects in remote villages," he said. According to Chavan, Madkam Aayta (25), a member of the platoon party committee of Maoists' PLGA battalion no. 1, and Bhaskar alias Bhogam Lakhha (26), a party member in the same battalion, each held a prize of ₹8 lakh for the Naxalites who turned themselves in. He claimed that six other Maoists had a bounty of ₹2 lakh apiece, while Madkam Kamlu, 25, and Laxman, also known as Madvi Chhananu, 28, both held ₹5 lakh.

Terrorist was killed in a blast in Amritsar while attempting to retrieve an explosive



Punjab, May 27: In Majitha Amritsar a terrorist suspected of having ties to the Babbar Khalsa terror group died this morning while attempting to recover an explosive. His identity is still unknown. "The man

who died was a member of a terrorist organisation. He died in a blast while trying to retrieve an explosive. We are investigating what was on their target. We have found some clues from his pants' pocket," said Satinder Singh, DIG of police border range. "It appears that he did not handle it properly, and it exploded," he added. The blast occurred near the bypass at Majitha road, said another official.

AMCA execution model approved by Defense Minister Rajnath Singh

New Delhi, May 27: The "execution model" for a significant domestic project to build India's fifth-generation, deep-penetration advanced medium combat aircraft for the Indian Air Force was approved by Defense Minister Rajnath Singh on Tuesday. This could make India the third nation to own such stealth fighter jets. Only two nations currently fly fifth-generation stealth fighters: China (J-20 and J-35) and the United States (F-22 and F-35). India recently accelerated the construction of the AMCA, which has increased stealth capabilities, with the goal of greatly boosting the nation's air strength, given that China has already built a sixth-generation aircraft. "In a significant push towards enhancing India's in-



digenous defence capabilities and fostering a robust domestic aerospace industrial ecosystem, Raksha Mantri Shri Rajnath Singh has approved AMCA Programme Execution Model," the Defence Ministry announced on Tuesday. Rajnath Singh called it an "important step towards harnessing the indigenous expertise, capability and capacity to develop the AMCA prototype, which will be a major milestone towards Aatmanirbharta in the aerospace sector".

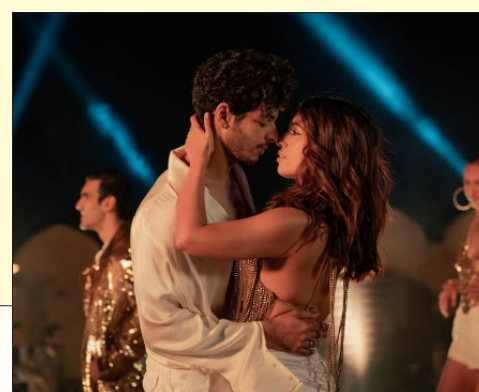
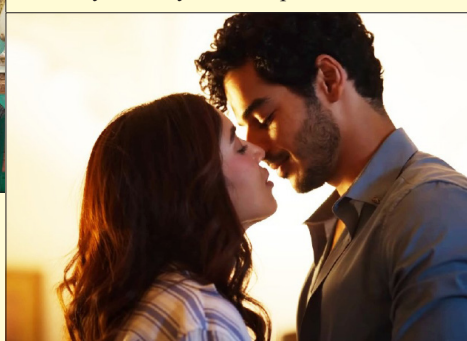
Season 2 of The Royals expecing led by Ishaan Khatter & Bhumi Pednekar

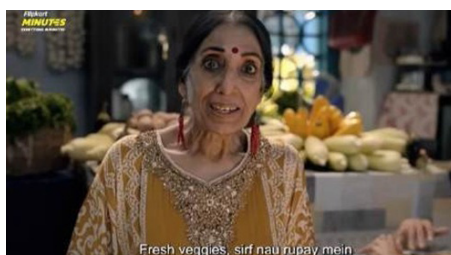

India's GDP is expected to increase

New Delhi, May 29: Survey of 20 experts, the Indian economy is expected to grow at its quickest rate in four quarters in Q4FY25 driven by consumer demand and agricultural performance. "GDP growth is expected to recover in Q4FY25 from the previous quarter driven by an improvement in consumer demand, government spending and healthy agriculture performance," said Sakshi Gupta, principal economist, HDFC Bank. However, India's economy will only reach 6.3 percent for FY25, falling short of the 6.5

percent expectation established by the second advance estimate. The growth prediction for FY25 was between 6.2 and 6.4 percent, with a median fixed at 6.3 percent. The government had to achieve 7.6% growth to reach the 6.5%. The government will release fourth quarter numbers along with provisional estimates for FY25. Although growth is expected to rise to a four-quarter high of 6.9 percent in Q4FY25, economists indicate that performance is likely to be more subdued, with subsidies payout contributing to higher jump.

Government proposes 36% stipend hike to boost apprenticeship training, eyes broader inclusion and sectoral expansion

Guwahati, May 29: To make apprenticeship programmes more attractive for youth, the Central Apprenticeship Council (CAC), chaired by Union Minister Jayant Chaudhary, has proposed a 36% hike in stipends under the National Apprenticeship Promotion Scheme (NAPS) and National Apprenticeship Training Scheme (NATS). The revised stipend range will move from ₹5,000–₹9,000 to ₹6,800–₹12,300, with biennial revisions based on CPI, subject to Cabinet approval. Held at VigyanBhawan, the 38th CAC meeting also emphasized inclusivity, proposing reserved training slots for persons with benchmark disabilities and measures to reduce dropout rates. The council backed apprenticeship-embedded education, sectoral expansion using NIC 2008 code, and digital training methods. For Guwahati, a regional industrial and educational hub, the revised stipend and structural reforms are likely to boost apprenticeship enrolment among urban and



semi-urban youth. The new policy could attract more MSMEs and academic institutions in Assam to join the national skilling ecosystem, creating better employment opportunities locally. The meeting also featured the launch of a KPMG report on NAPS data and saw participation from key industry bodies, academic institutions, and government representatives. The recommendations aim to align apprenticeship with India's development goals under 'Kushal Bharat, Viksit Bharat'.

Experts urge thyroid checks for diabetics as dual disorders pose hidden health risks

Guwahati, May 29: With nearly 1 in 11 adults in India living with diabetes and 1 in 10 affected by thyroid disorders, medical experts are highlighting a significant health concern—up to one in four people with Type 2 diabetes also suffer from hypothyroidism, often undiagnosed. The thyroid gland, which regulates metabolism, plays a crucial role in energy management alongside insulin. When thyroid function is disrupted, it can impair blood sugar control, increasing the risk of complications such as heart disease, kidney issues, and diabetic retinopathy. Dr Rohita Shetty, Medical Affairs Head, Abbott India said, "People living with diabetes are usually aware of their blood sugar levels and know how to manage the fluctuations. But many symptoms of thyroid disorders might go unnoticed, even though they can impact blood sugar levels. Thyroid health and blood sugar levels are more linked than you might think. That's why it's important to get regular thyroid check-ups. With the right care, thyroid disorders can be managed effectively, allowing people to live healthy and active lives."



Dr. Nilakshi Deka, Endocrinologist, Apollo Hospital, Guwahati, "Thyroid conditions are often neglected, with a large percentage of the population living with undetected issues and, as a result, not seeking the necessary care. Many people with diabetes may have thyroid problems without noticeable symptoms, which can range from fatigue, memory lapses, sleeping difficulties and excessive weight gain to constipation, dry skin, cold intolerance, muscle cramps, and puffy eyelids. An underactive thyroid can also result in fluctuations in energy levels, weight, mood, and heart rate, as the gland plays an important role in regulating these functions

and supporting the body's healthy development. This is why regular check-ups for thyroid function are important, especially for people with type 2 diabetes." In Guwahati, where diabetes management awareness has been steadily growing, healthcare providers are increasingly recommending thyroid screening for diabetic patients. Market trends show a rise in demand for diagnostic services and medications targeting both conditions, reflecting growing public health concern in urban areas like Guwahati. Managing both conditions requires lifestyle changes, regular monitoring, and medical supervision to maintain a healthy, active life.

Q4 net profit of Suzlon Energy increased 365% to Rs 1,182cr

Mumbai, May 29: Due mostly to an extraordinary gain, Suzlon Energy reported a 365 percent increase in consolidated net profit to Rs 1,181 crore for the March quarter on Thursday.

A deferred tax advantage of Rs 600 crore increased the net profit of the provider of renewable energy solutions. According to an NSE filing, the company's consolidated net profit for the previous year was Rs 254 crore.

Additionally, the consolidated net profit increased from Rs 660 crore in the previous fiscal year to Rs 2,072 crore in 2024–2025. In the March quarter of FY25, the company's overall revenue from operations increased by 73.2 percent to Rs 3,773.5 crore, up from Rs 2,179.2 crore during the same period the previous year. While the margin was



17.94 percent compared to 15.62 percent year-over-year (YoY), the earnings before interest, taxes, depreciation, and amortization (EBITDA) increased 99 percent to Rs 677 crore from Rs 340.4 crore in the previous year. Its overall revenue increased from Rs 2,207.43 crore to Rs 3,825.19 crore during the quarter. "FY25 performance sets the

stage for Suzlon's next phase of strategic evolution and market leadership. Achieving our highest profitability in a decade, strong cash reserves, and a record order book are the direct outcomes of our disciplined business transformation and sharp operational focus," Girish Tanti, Vice Chairman, Suzlon Group, said.

A decline in inflation boosts confidence

New Delhi, May 29: The Reserve Bank of India stated in its annual report that a drop in retail prices below its medium-term aim of 4 percent gives confidence in a long-term alignment of headline inflation with the target of 4 percent over a 12-month horizon. "With inflation falling below the target in February and March 2025, supported by a sharp fall in food inflation, there is now greater confidence about a durable alignment of headline

inflation with the target of 4.0 per cent over a 12-month horizon," the report, released on May 29, said. Retail inflation slowed to 3.16 percent in April from 3.34 percent in March, the lowest year-on-year reading since July 2019.

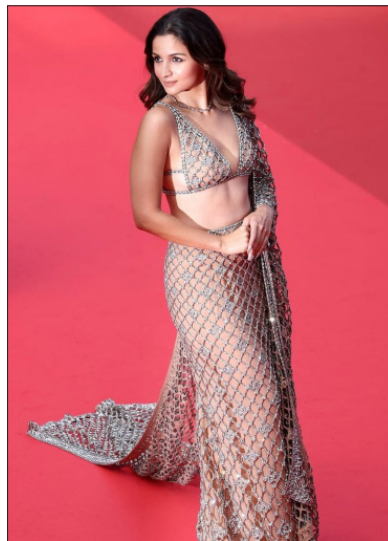
Increasing incidences of climate shocks, as seen in recent years, however, warrant careful monitoring of food price outlook, the report said.
